



# **FPL's Solar Rebate Pilot Programs Guide for Residential and Business Customers**

## FPL's Solar Rebate Programs

- **FPL's solar rebates are part of a five-year pilot program authorized by the Florida Public Service Commission to promote clean solar power and reduce energy consumption**
- **Rebates are limited and will be available on a first-come-first-served basis**
- **Any system components installed prior to FPL's issuance of a rebate reservation will not qualify for the rebate**

# Program Standards: All Programs

- **All metered residential and business retail rate schedules are eligible**
- **These programs are for existing premises\* and buildings**
- **New construction is not eligible**
- **The reservation must be obtained prior start of construction**
- **The building permit issuance date must be after the reservation date**
- **Equipment must be installed by a licensed contractor**
- **Self-installation is only permitted for governmental customers and contractors with the appropriate license**

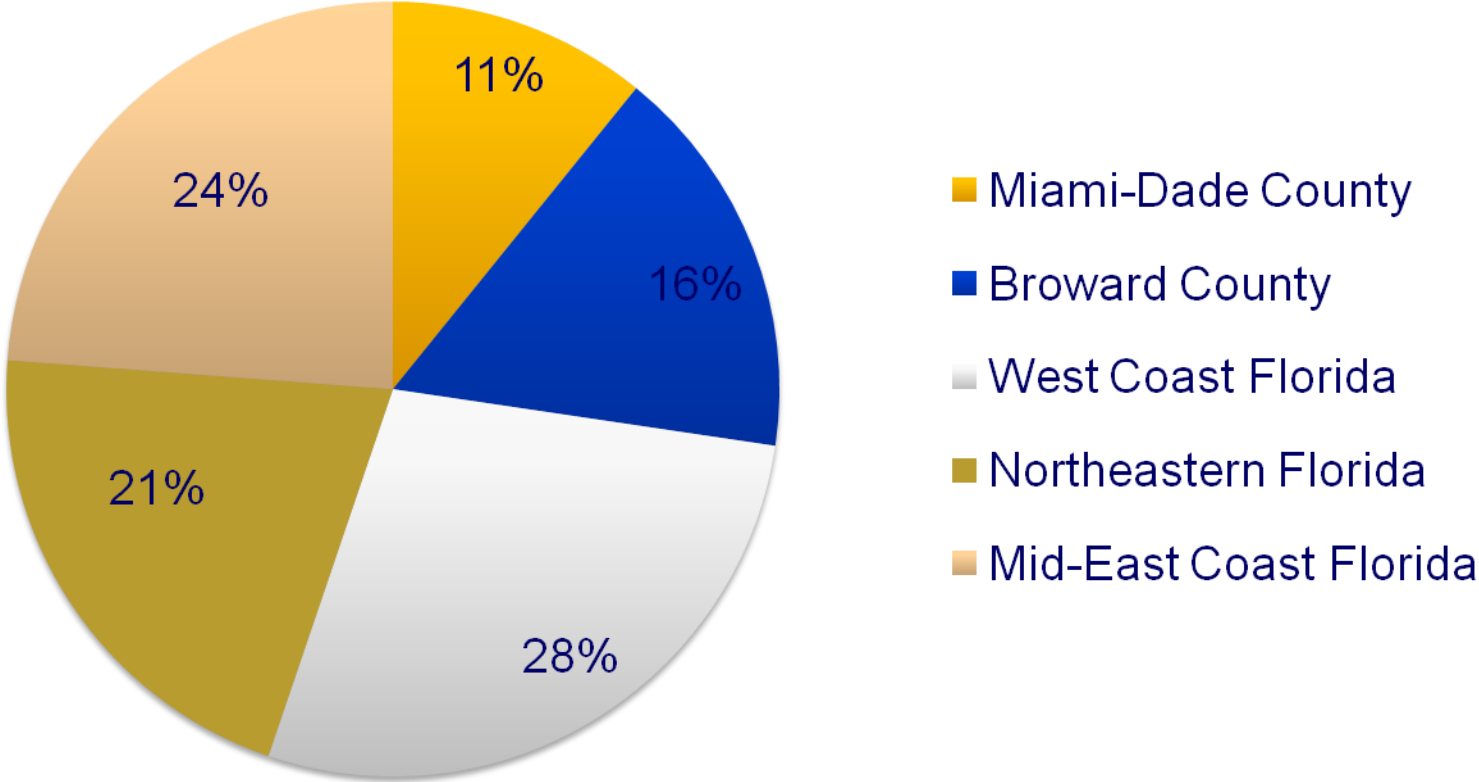
\*A premise is defined as a dwelling or business under the control of a single customer where electric utility service terminates. Separate buildings and adjoining buildings in a group of buildings, which have separate FPL electric service, and contain separate dwellings or businesses, are separate premises.

# Program Standards: All Programs cont.

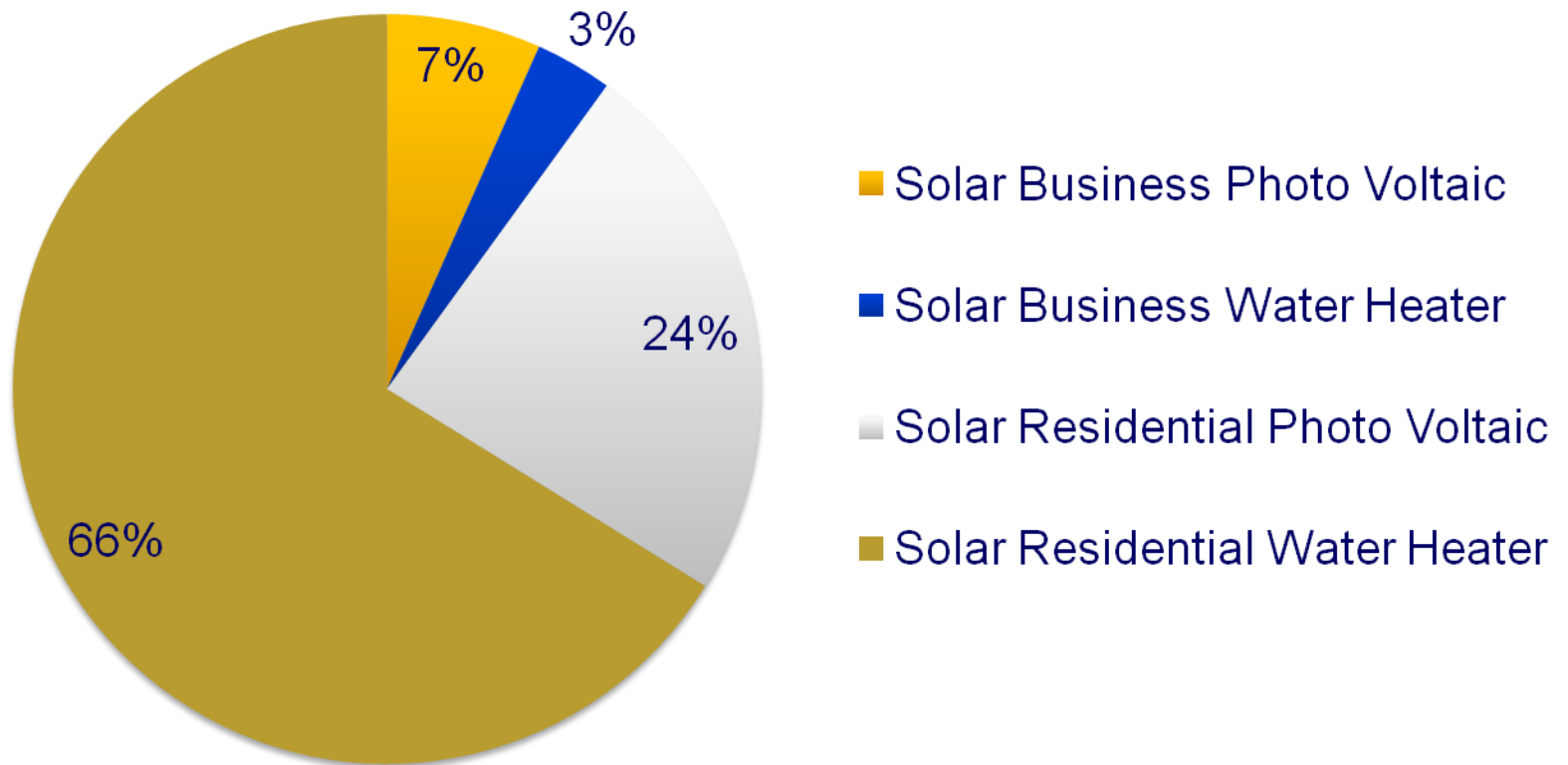
- Each premise\* is eligible for one rebate per program for the duration of the five year pilot program
- Construction must be completed and all required documents received by FPL within 90 days for residential, and 120 days for business of the date of FPL's reservation approval
- All products installed must be new, not refurbished nor previously installed
- Solar collectors / arrays must be mounted flat or tilted to a south, east or west (North-facing collectors or arrays will not receive a rebate)

- Reservations must be reserved through your online account at [www.FPL.com](http://www.FPL.com)
- If you do not have online access to your account, register for it before October 2011
- Obtain a building permit and have the contractor you choose and hire build a system that meets all program standards and requirements
- When construction is complete, fill out the rebate certificate and provide all required documentation to FPL
- You will receive the rebate six to eight weeks after your documentation is approved
